- Samantha gave updates on Town Activities.
 - Park staff has taken over mowing as part of Covid cost savings. Continuing with need maintenance as time permits.
 - Major Park improvements as outlined in Master Plan on hold.
 - Town Summer Rec Program cancelled. Joint Town/City program running at reduced capacity.
 - Beaches have opened with appropriate Covid guidelines in place.
 - Rentals open for Park facilities.
- Movie Night Cancelled
 - Too much uncertainty at this time. Events Committee has also cancelled Halloween at Onanda.
- Bench Sponsorship
 - Dan sent out mock up of posting for bench sponsorship. Will work next couple of weeks to finalize and look to get info out in Town Newsletter ASAP. Future item-possibility of “Tree Sponsors” similar program in City of Canandaigua. Maybe connection to Town Tree Committee.
- Town Parks and Rec Code Review
 - Members will begin a review of the Parks & Rec portion of Town Code and look for areas in need of updating.
- Onanda
 - Busy summer at Onanda and all Town Parks. People looking for activities to get outdoors and stay busy.
 - Gorham Hall.—Concern over large porch with no rail or stairs. Maintenance looking at solutions but need to take into account new septic field in front of building.

- 2021 Budget
 - Early stages of budget development. Nothing new to report at this time.
- Gypsy Moth Control
 - Discussed possibilities for addressing current Gypsy Moth infestation in and around Parks. Small scale, local baiting possibilities. Also suggestion to touch base with other Town groups and create coordinated plan. Will check with Environmental Board and Tree Board for more info.
