New Resolutions:

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 - 260: CREATION OF A CAPITAL PROJECT FOR NORTH ROAD COMPLETE STREET (H41)

WHEREAS, the Town of Canandaigua Town Board acknowledges North Road in the Town of Canandaigua should be considered for reconstruction as a Complete Street; and

WHEREAS, a "Complete Street" is defined as a roadway that is planned and designed to cater to the safe and convenient access and mobility of all roadway users, including pedestrians, bicyclists, public transportation riders, and motorists, irrespective of age or ability, and such roadways feature a range of design elements such as sidewalks, lane striping, bicycle lanes, signage, crosswalks, and traffic calming measures; and

WHEREAS, the adoption and implementation of Complete Streets principles are expected to contribute to a cleaner, more sustainable transportation system and promote active forms of transportation, leading to health benefits for residents while reducing traffic congestion and auto-related air pollution; and

WHEREAS, studies, including the 2015 Smart Growth America study, "Safer Streets, Stronger Economies," have shown that Complete Streets projects tend to enhance safety, increase biking and walking, and result in varying effects on automobile traffic, depending on project goals; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has received a proposal from MRB Group in the amount of \$266,780 for North Road Roadway Reconstruction and Sidewalk Engineering approved by the Town Board on

October 16, 2023 via Resolution No. 2023 - 252 and directed the Town Manager to create a Capital Project funding such expenditure consisting of funding of 60% of the cost from the Capital Project (H39) known as Roadway Reconstruction, and 40% of the cost from the Capital Project known as Complete Streets (H38); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Canandaigua that:

- 1. The Town Board recognizes the significance of implementing Complete Streets principles within the Town of Canandaigua to enhance transportation facilities and improve accessibility for all users.
- 2. The Town Board directs the Town Manager to create a capital project and the necessary account lines for the North Road Complete Street Project (H41). This project will focus on transforming North Road into a Complete Street, incorporating design elements that prioritize the safety and convenience of pedestrians, bicyclists, public transportation riders, and motorists of all ages and abilities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Canandaigua hereby authorizes the Town Manger to make the following adjustments for proper accounting of revenues and expenses separate from the Town's annual budget:

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 – 261 : CREATION OF A CAPITAL PROJECT AND BUDGET FOR TOWN HALL RENOVATION (H42)

WHEREAS, the Town of Canandaigua Town Board (herein after referred to as "Town Board") has previously accepted a proposal from MRB for the professional services for Town Hall Renovations per approval of Resolution No. 2023-253;

WHEREAS, per resolution No. 2023-253 the cost for proposal from MRB Group dated July 7, 2023, for services of Town Hall Office Renovations shall not exceed \$63,500.00;

WHEREAS, the Town Manager has informed the Town Board as of October 18th, 2023 the General Fund's unassigned fund balance is approximately \$3,123,124.71, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Manager has informed the Town Board as of October 18th, 2023 the Campus Repair Reserve fund balance is approximately \$215,646.68, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Manager has recommended the appropriation of the Campus Capital Reserve funds for this project;

WHEREAS, the Town Manager is proposing the appropriation unappropriated fund balance until the required time limit has been met for the permissive referendum to use funds from the Campus Reserve Fund.

WHEREAS, the Town Manager and Finance Clerk II are recommending the creation of a capital project to more easily track the Town Hall Renovation project as expenses are expected to be incurred in multiple budget years; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board hereby authorizes the creation of a capital project to be known as H42 – TH Reno and directs the Town Manager and Finance Clerk II to create the following capital project budget:

REVENUE: HH100.5031.00042	Interfund Transfer (General)	\$63,500.00
EXPENDITURES: HH100.1440.200.00042	Engineering.Capital.TH Reno	\$63,500.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town Board hereby directs the Town Manager and Finance Clerk II to make the following budget transfers to account for the Town's contribution to this project:

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, the Town Clerk is directed to provide a copy of this resolution to the Finance Clerk and the Town Manager.

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 - 262: 2024 DENTAL CARE PROGRAM SELECTION

WHEREAS, the Human Resources & Coordinator has received the dental plan rates for 2024 and along with the Town Manager, is recommending continuing the same plan and cost share with eligible employees (as defined by the Employee Handbook); and

WHEREAS, the cost share states eligible employees subscribing to the plan shall continue to contribute 25% of the total plan cost; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 monthly premiums amounts are: single Subscriber \$42.40, Subscriber and Spouse \$84.80, Subscriber and Child(ren) \$87.67, and Family \$139.12; and

WHEREAS, the proposed 2024 monthly premiums amounts are: single Subscriber \$43.43, Subscriber and Spouse \$86.87, Subscriber and Child(ren) \$90.58, and Family \$143.47; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby authorizes the Town Manager to execute a contract with Matson and Kellogg for the Excellus Dental Plan DBOE-1 for the calendar year 2024; and approves of eligible employees contributing 25% of the total plan cost; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town Board directs the Town Clerk to provide a copy of this resolution to the Human Resources & Payroll Coordinator and the Finance Clerk II.
