AGREEMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF HIGHWAY MONEYS

AGREEMENT between the Highway Superintendent of the Town of Canandaigua, Ontario County, New York, and the undersigned members of the Town Board.

Pursuant to the provisions of <u>Section 284</u> of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected in the Town for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the State for State Aid for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

GENERAL REPAIRS / PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS

The sum of \$1,750,000.00.00 shall be set aside to be expended for primary work and general repairs upon _____102.60___ miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than twenty feet and boardwalks or the renewals thereof.

The following is a list for the permanent improvement of Town highways:

- 1. Various repairs on town roads \$ 253,000.00.
- 2. Paving of roads
 - a. Middle Cheshire Road. 450,000.00
 - b. Emerson Road \$ 450,000.00
 - c. Stablegate subdivision \$ 150,000
 - d. Arnold Drive \$ 120,000
 - e. Canandaigua Farmington Townline Road \$ 77,500
- 3. Nova Chip Cooley Road \$ 250,000.00

Total Estimated Expenditure \$1,750,000.00
