

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017 – 235: AUTHORIZATION OF INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT WITH ONTARIO COUNTY FOR COURT SECURITY**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Canandaigua Town Court and Ontario County on behalf of the Ontario County Sheriff's department have requested an extension of an intermunicipal agreement providing court security services to the Town of Canandaigua Town Court; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of Canandaigua wishes to extend the agreement for the calendar year 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of the agreement is included with this agenda and is identified as Attachment 22 to the agenda; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town Board of the Town of Canandaigua hereby approves of the intermunicipal agreement extension for the calendar year 2017; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Town Board of the Town of Canandaigua authorizes the Town Manager to execute the intermunicipal agreement for court security services with Ontario County.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017 – 236: AUTHORIZATION OF RFP FOR FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES IN THE TOWN OF CANANDAIGUA**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of Canandaigua (herein after referred to as "Town Board") is interested in additional information relative to the most efficient use of taxpayer resources specifically in terms of fire and rescue services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board wishes to receive additional information from current and potential organizations capable of contracting with the Town of Canandaigua for fire and rescue services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board has reviewed the Request for Proposals (RFP) described in further detail identified as Attachment 23; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Town Board to achieve the greatest level of fire and rescue services for the residents and property owners of the Town of Canandaigua while also being vigilant to ensure the most cost efficient manner is being achieved for such service; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town Board of the Town of Canandaigua hereby approves of the RFP associated with this resolution identified in the above attachment and directs the Town Manager to release the RFP through all normal channels of RFP; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Town Board directs the Town Manager to send a copy of the RFP to all neighboring fire service units of the Town of Canandaigua in Ontario County as well as the Ontario County Office of Emergency Management and return any and all responses to the Town Board for further consideration.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017 – 237: AUTHORIZATION OF SARATOGA ASSOCIATES PROPOSAL FOR WORK WITH THE NATURAL RESOURCE INVENTORY TEAM ON THE RIDGELINE VIEWSHED PROPOSED PROTECTION LAW**

**WHEREAS**, the Natural Resource Inventory Team (herein after referred to as 'NRI Team') has been charged with putting forth proposals to implement the portion of the Town of Canandaigua

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*Jean Saratoga*  
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Comprehensive Plan that pertains to Natural Resource protection including steep slope protection, ridgeline protection, and shoreline protection; and

**WHEREAS**, the NRI Team has been working for two years on proposals relative to steep slope and ridgeline protection; and

**WHEREAS**, the NRI Team has put together a draft ridgeline and viewshed protection law; however, they need professional assistance in understanding ~~the full understanding~~ of the implementation of such a law to ensure the uniform enforceability of such a proposal; and

**WHEREAS**, the NRI Team has spoken with Saratoga Associates who has completed a number of these types of actions with other municipalities during professional assistance; and

**WHEREAS**, the NRI Team evaluated an initial proposal from Saratoga Associates at a cost of \$ 8,000; however, through work already completed by the NRI Team was able to further discuss with Saratoga Associates to reduce the cost to the Town of Canandaigua to \$ 2,700; and

**WHEREAS**, the NRI Team had requested an amount of \$ 3,500 be budgeted by the Town Board in the 2017 Town budget A.8020.400; and

**WHEREAS**, the NRI Team is recommending to the Town Board of the Town of Canandaigua (herein after referred to as 'Town Board') the utilization of Saratoga ~~Associations~~ <sup>Associates</sup> to assist them with a proposed local law that would further clarify language associated with ridgeline and viewshed protection; and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of the proposal is included with this agenda and is identified as Attachment 24 to the agenda; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town Board of the Town of Canandaigua authorize the Town Manager to execute all documents relative to the acceptance of the Saratoga Associates proposal dated June 5, 2017 for services performed in relation to the drafting and analysis of a Ridgeline Viewshed Protection Law at a cost not to exceed \$ 2,700.00 to be funded through Town of Canandaigua 2017 Town Budget A.8020.400.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017 – 238: APPROVAL OF TOWN-APPROVED 3<sup>RD</sup> PARTY LICENSED ELECTRICAL INSPECTION AGENCIES TO BE DISTRIBUTED BY THE DEVELOPMENT OFFICE**

**WHEREAS**, in the Town of Canandaigua, all electrical work performed within the specifications of a building permit issued by the Town Development Office is required to be inspected by a 3<sup>rd</sup> party licensed electrical inspector; and

**WHEREAS**, the Development Office has a list, which appears to have been last updated more than a dozen years ago, of Town-approved licensed electrical inspection agencies and individual inspectors to be distributed to permit applicants when building permits are issued; and

**WHEREAS**, the Development Office wishes to update the list and provide a more record of the Town Board having approved of the list included here as Attachment 25; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of Town of Canandaigua Code Enforcement Officers to utilize the attached list of 3<sup>rd</sup> party licensed electrical inspectors; and
